ARCHERY

- 10 shots fired at 20 yards
- 8 out of 10 arrows must strike scoring target area to pass
- Only one failure to qualify is permitted
- Shooter may pay \$10 to attempt to re-qualify



SHOTGUN

- 6 shots at 25, 35, 45, 55, 65 and 70 yards
- 5 out of 6 shots must strike scoring target area to pass
- Only one failure to qualify is permitted
- Shooter may pay \$10 to attempt to re-qualify

ARCHERY

- Legal archery equipment is defined by the Ohio Division of Wildlife Hunting Rules and Regulations.
- You must qualify with the equipment you will use during hunting.
- You must have five arrows.
- You must have field points on arrows equivalent to the weight grain on broadheads used to hunt.

FIREARM

- Legal shotgun, muzzleloader or pistol is defined by the Ohio Division of Wildlife Hunting Rules and Regulations.
- You must qualify with the equipment you will use during hunting.
- All equipment to fire six rounds.
