GUIDELINES FOR USE

Welcome to Geauga Park District's Bass Lake Lodge. We hope your visit is an enjoyable one. In order to ensure the facility is well maintained for all who use it, we ask you to observe the following guidelines:

- Please leave the lodge in the same condition that you found it.
- Return the tables to original positions.
- Trash Container – Please leave your trash in cans provided in the lodge.
- Remove all traces of decorations, including tape, and any signage before leaving, especially signs left at the park entrance. Do not use staples or tacks on walls. Do not place signs/balloons on entrance signs leading to park.
- You must bring in your own water for drinking and clean up.
- The Bass Lake Lodge is locked when not in use. You must pick up the key at the Donald W. Meyer Center, Big Creek Park, 9160 Robinson Road in Chardon no sooner than one (1) day before your event. The Meyer Center is open weekdays 8:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m.; weekends May through October, 10:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m. (closed weekends November - April). A deposit of \$100 in cash or on a Visa or MasterCard will be required and held until the key is returned. **YOUR RESERVATION ALLOWS ACCESS TO THE LODGE ONLY ON THE DAY OF YOUR RESERVATION. YOU MAY NOT SET UP THE ROOM THE DAY BEFORE, BECAUSE THERE MAY BE OTHER RESERVATIONS SCHEDULED.**
- Upon leaving, please lock the door and place key in the lock box located outside the lodge (right-hand side) or return key to the Meyer Center within 2 days of your event. Failure to do so will result in forfeiture of your deposit and loss of rights to future reservations.



Amenities inside the Lodge

- Maximum capacity – 80 people.
- Fourteen 8-ft. tables, two 4-foot round tables, and 80 chairs are available.
- Electrical outlets. Please do not plug in more than 3 items per outlet to avoid overloading the circuit.
- Alcohol is permitted inside the lodge only. Alcohol is not permitted outside of the lodge or in areas adjacent to the lodge, such as the parking lot or grass areas.
- Smoking is not permitted in the lodge.
- Heat is available at the lodge. The heat will be turned on for all reservations which take place from October 15th through April 1st. The heat fee is \$25 per session and must be paid in advance at the time the reservation is made. Preferred method of payment is by credit card. Geauga Park District accepts Visa and MasterCard. Patrons may also opt to have the heat turned on during other months and will be required to pay the \$25.00 per session heat fee at the time the reservation is made. Late requests for heat require a 3-day notice.

Amenities outside the Lodge

- Charcoal grill
- Port-o-let restroom facilities
- Parking facilities for maximum 30 vehicles

Please note that your reservation does not include permission to boat or fish on Bass Lake. Shoreline fishing is prohibited. A daily boat permit may be obtained in advance online at www.geaugaparkdistrict.org or by calling 440-286-9516. Rules and regulations for boating and fishing are explained in the boat permit.

Spring Brook, which runs alongside the lodge is a protected State Nature Preserve and is off limits for fishing and wading. Please heed signs.
